We accept cremated remains year around and un-embalmed natural remains April through October, for Natural Green Burial. All Natural Burials are by arrangement and generally arrive by hearse, but it is also legal in Montana, with some restrictions, to personally transport most human and all animal remains (<http://www.mtrules.org/gateway/RuleNo.asp?RN=37.116.103>). It is advisable to have a death certificate with you. Laws in other jurisdictions will vary, and permits may be required. With prior arrangement, we will pick up bodies shipped here by air freight for Green Burial. We also accept animal cremated and natural remains under the same terms and conditions. The US Postal Service Priority Mail Express is the only legally sanctioned way to easily ship cremated human remains. (*Animal cremated remains are not subject to the legal requirements of human cremated remains.*) FedEx, UPS or other shippers will not *knowing* accept human cremated remains for shipment. USPS Priority Mail Express costs range from about \$40 (smallest size) to about \$110, or more, depending on the size and weight of the urn or inner container. International shipments may be sent via Priority Mail Express International.

Shipped cremated remains must be packaged in two containers. The first container must be an inner, leak-proof container and should be wrapped in padding material for protection. A strong sealed plastic bag meets this inner container requirement, as well as most sealed cremation urns. An urn is required for international shipments. We recommend that identification of the remains (deceased name and date of death), along with the sender's contact information, and our address be taped to the inner package also. The second secure outer shipping container is used to enclose the inner leak-proof container. Contents with human cremated remains must be clearly identified as CREMATED REMAINS on the address side of the package.

Shipping Tips:

- The Priority Mail Express boxes provided by the USPS are generally too small to fit anything except small rectangular box cremation urns, or a strong plastic bag of ashes. *We encourage this shipping method.* The largest free USPS Priority Mail Express boxes have inside dimensions of 11" x 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" or 15-1/4" x 12-3/8" x 3". You will probably need a larger box for most decorative urns, which will then be recycled or destroyed by us, after the enclosed cremated remains are returned to nature by burial at Infinity Cemetery.
- For USPS Priority Mail Express, use Label 11-B. 2nd Day Delivery is sufficient.
- PRINT firmly and legibly with a ball point pen.
- Request to take a photo of the label after the postal clerk has filled in the red portion.
- Each shipment has a tracking number. ***Make sure to record your tracking number.***
- We will contact you by email when the package is received.
